

1888 Slater's Directory

Part 30 Description of Ramsbottom and alphabetical list of residents, from 'Adshead' to 'Kay'.

Part 31 Alphabetical list of residents, from 'Kay' to 'Zally'. Classification of Trades.

Part 32 Classification of Trades, Public Buildings and Street Register of Principal Streets.

Part 33 Street Register of Principal Streets.




